Reverend Professor George Kwamina Toworfe is a Professor in Biomaterials Science and Bioengineering. Prof. Toworfe is currently a faculty member in a University in the Gulf. Prof Toworfe has an accomplished career demonstrating consistent success as an academic and administrator (as Head of Department, Dean, Provost, President) at Higher Education institutions across 4 continents over the past 30 years.

Prof Toworfe obtained Ph.D in Biomaterials Science from University of Manchester, UK. He was awarded a Postdoctoral Research Fellowship programme in Biomedical Engineering at the University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, USA.

In addition, Prof Toworfe has a Masters degree in Theological Studies (MThS), a Masters degree in Physics (MPhil), a Bachelors degree in Physics & Mathematics (BSc-Hons) and a Diploma in Education (Dip. Ed.). He has extensive scientific publications in world-renowned peer-reviewed journals and serves on the Editorial and Review boards of numerous international Scientific journals and Christian magazines. Prof Toworfe has exhibited expertise in the creation, implementation and coordination of lifelong learning programmes and the personalized development of appropriate strategies and meaningful activities to propel teaching and learning in Higher Education.

In recognition of his professionalism as an academic, a researcher and an administrator, coupled with his commitment to and a sustained record of effectiveness in relation to teaching, learning and engagement in a practical process that encourages research, reflection and development, Prof Toworfe was awarded the status of **Senior Fellow (SFHEA)**, in 2018, by the Advanced Higher Education, UK (a single central body responsible for standards of teaching, leadership and governance in Higher Education, worldwide), a real testament to his exemplary work which demonstrates not only his successful professional practice but most importantly his sustained influence and impact on the teaching and learning practices of colleagues. Prof Toworfe is one of 10,000 academics, worldwide, who has been awarded Senior Fellowship status by the Advanced Higher Education, UK.

Prof Toworfe was called into ministry during the early 1980s, and ordained as a Reverend Minister by Adonai International Fellowship Alliance (AIFA) in the US. Over the years, Prof Toworfe has pioneered the establishment of churches, mentored pastors and ministers, lectured and taught in Bible Colleges. He has helped to establish, build and nurture churches in Ghana, USA and UK. He was an associate pastor of two Charismatic churches in London, UK. He is currently one of the Pastors in one of the largest Assemblies of God churches in the United Kingdom. Professor Toworfe is the Vice President of the UK/Europe chapter of the Global Christian Ministry Forum (GCMF) and a member of numerous professional/scientific and religious organisations, worldwide.
